Question: Text: Instructions for battery toys intended to be used in water shall state that the toy is to be operated in water only when fully assembled in accordance with the instructions. 1. Does "assembly" in this instance also include the battery compartment lid? 2. If there is no "assembly" is this requirement applicable?		
Proposer's Comments for an answer: The instruction "Only operate after being fully assembled according to these instructions" (or similar) seems superfluous when the only assembly is a battery door. The instruction is certainly not needed when the batteries are sealed within the toy.

<p style="color: red;">28.10.2011 If the only "assembly" is the removal of the battery door, then there is no need to state the toy should be fully assembled. However would recommend that the instructions refer to ensuring the battery door is secure before operating in water. If there is no assembly (the batteries are sealed in place) then clearly no need to state anything in the instructions. This was agreed. (#059 to be closed.)</p>
