Question

The clause states:

“Non-detachable parts that prevent contact with moving parts or hot surfaces, or access to locations where explosion or fire could be initiated, shall be fixed in a reliable manner...”

How are “locations where explosion or fire could be initiated” defined? Should this only be applied to toys with moving parts or hot surfaces?

Interpretations Group Answer /Action

Apply to non-detachable parts that prevent contact with moving parts or hot surfaces. Examples of the other situations, i.e., explosion or fire, could not be envisaged however toys should be examined on a case by case basis.
