### Question

A soft-filled doll has a disposable type of nappy. The nappy is made of plastic sheet and filled with polyester fibre. The nappy can easily be removed (Velcro fastening).

How would the flammability test be carried out :

- a) Doll wearing nappy
- b) Doll wearing nappy & also doll without nappy
- c) Doll wearing nappy, plus doll without nappy, plus nappy on its own?

### Interpretations Group Answer /Action

- a) The Committee agreed that the Doll should be tested as option c - Doll wearing nappy, plus doll without nappy, plus nappy on its own.
