The BTHA's interpretations group consisting of BTHA members, test laboratories, manufacturers, importers and retailers has agreed upon the following interpretation.

<b>Interpretation no.</b>	102P
<b>Date of submission</b>	18/03/2013
<b>Standard/Directive</b>	EN71-1: 2011
<b>Clause No</b>	5.0 and 5.8
<b>Clause Title</b>	Toys intended for children under 36 months and size and shape of certain toys.

### Question

If a toy is age graded and tested as 2+ years, and it complies with EN 71-1 clause 5 apart from 5.1(f) and 5.8. Can it be labeled 2+ and no warning statement is required on the packaging.

### Interpretations Group Answer /Action

If the toy is manifestly not for a child that cannot sit up unaided, a warning is not required by the standard.
